Trashy Town

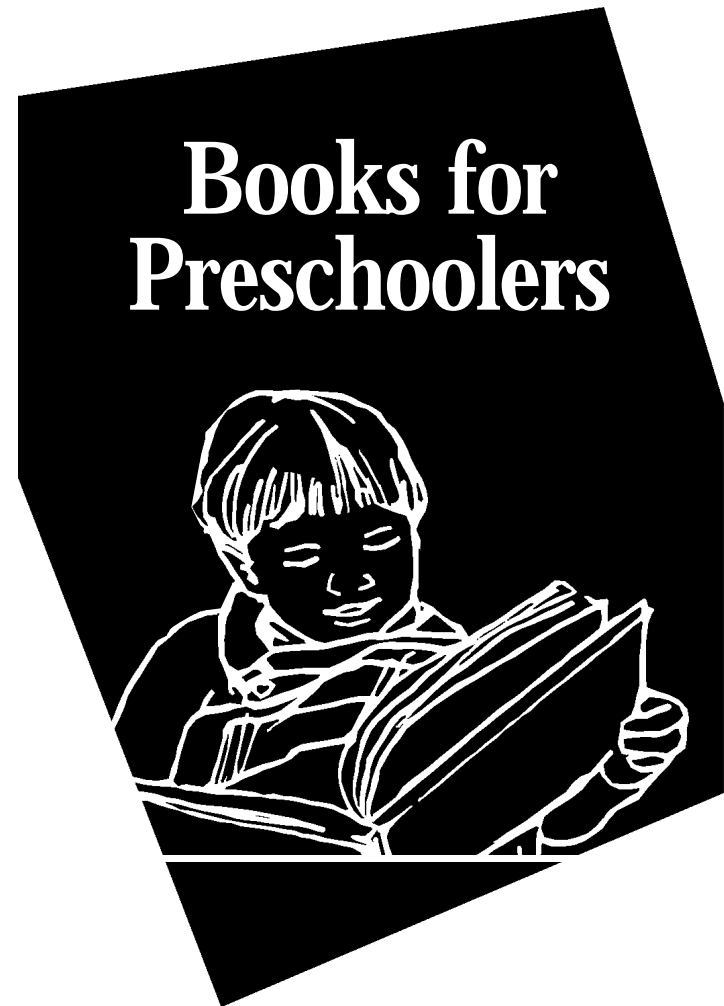
Zimmerman, Andrea
